OVERVIEW OF THE CENTRAL POLICE STATION

The Central Police Station (CPS) Revitalisation Project (the Project) is an important initiative to conserve and revitalise the heritage site comprising the Central Police Station, the Victoria Prison and the Central Magistracy for adaptive reuse. The Project is a partnership of The Government of the Hong Kong SAR and The Hong Kong Jockey Club Charities Trust (The Trust). The Project aims to creatively transform a unique cluster of historically significant buildings in Hong Kong into a vibrant centre for heritage, contemporary art and leisure with access for the public to enjoy.

中區警署建築群概覽

中區警署建築群活化計劃是香港的保育活化重點項目之一·目的是保育及活化再用中區警署、域多利監獄和中央裁判司署組成的古蹟建築群。這項計劃是香港特別行政區政府與香港賽馬會慈善信託基金(基金)的合作項目,透過保育活化香港其中一個最獨特的古蹟建築群,為公眾提供一處結合文物、當代藝術和消閒設施的文化活動空間。

The Project includes the conservation of 16 buildings of historical or architectural significance and several open spaces on a site measuring approximately 3.37 acres (13,600 square metres). To support the new cultural activities on the revitalised site, an international renowned firm of architects, Herzog & de Meuron has been engaged to design two new buildings, tentatively named 'Arbuthnot Auditorium' and 'Old Bailey Gallery'. These new buildings will provide additional floor spaces for contemporary art and exhibition areas, educational activities and buildings facilities, and will help to reduce interventions to the historic buildings.

The architectural design of the Project is the collaborative work of Herzog & de Meuron from Switzerland, the conservation architects Purcell from the United Kingdom and Rocco Design Architects, the Hong Kong based executive architect. 本項目涵蓋16幢具歷史價值或建築特色的建築物和數個戶外開放空間,面積合共約3.37 英畝(13,600平方米)。為提供適當活動空間,活化計劃包括興建兩座新建築物,設計工作由國際知名的建築事務所赫爾佐格和德默隆(Herzog & de Meuron)負責。這兩座新建築物暫名為「亞畢諾綜藝館」和「奧卑利美術館」,將提供額外空間作當代藝術,及教育活動用途,並裝配建築設施,而其建設工程將會減少對歷史建築物造成影響。

項目的建築設計工作,由瑞士建築事務所赫爾佐格和德默隆、英國保育建築師事務所Purcell,和設於香港的行政建築師許李嚴建築師事務有限公司共同負責。



After the revitalisation works, it is estimated the Project will comprise an approximate total construction floor area of 300,000 square feet (27,900 square metres). Approximately 37% of the construction floor area will be used for heritage and contemporary art, 36% for public circulation and buildings facilities and 27% for commercial use to provide leisure and entertainment to the visitors. The Prison Yard and Parade Ground will be preserved and together with other additional spaces, the total area of major open spaces on the site will be over 40,000 square feet (3,700 square metres). These will offer attractive urban courtyards.

The venue is planned to be an inclusive and inviting destination supported by a number of restaurants, cafés and shops to enrich visitor experience and provide income to help sustain the maintenance and operation of the heritage site. The Project targets for completion in the second half of 2016.

本項目的活化工程完成後,總建築面積將達300,000平方呎(27,900平方米),當中約37%用於文物欣賞及當代藝術推廣,36%用於公眾通道及建築設施,其餘27%用作商業用途,為訪客提供消閒娛樂體驗。此外,建築群內的監獄操場和檢閱廣場將會保留,連同其他增設的空間,令主要的露天空間多逾40,000平方呎(3,700平方米),當中包括寧雅清幽的庭園。

建築群將按規劃發展成綜合式文化空間,設有餐廳、咖啡室和商店,為訪客提供更豐富的體驗,而從中所得的租金收入,將作建築群的維修及持續營運之用。本項目預計於2016年下半年落成。





LOCATION

The Central Police Station compound is located in Central district on Hong Kong Island. The site is bordered on three sides by vehicular roads: Old Bailey Street, Hollywood Road and Arbuthnot Road. Chancery Lane runs along the southern prison wall.

This is a vibrant and bustling part of the city centre, with easy access to other important heritage sites. Hollywood Road is a busy street dotted with galleries, bars and restaurants. The Mid-Levels escalator system will be connected to the CPS site by a new footbridge planned to be built at the key intersection of Hollywood Road and Old Bailey Street, to provide easier access to the site.




POLICE HEADQUARTERS BLOCK 警察總部大樓

Completed in 1919, the Police Headquarters Block is one of the most imposing structures on the site. Forming the public face of the Central Police Station complex, the exterior design of the façade is a Neo-Classical revival on the north elevation and a more domestic and small-scale Classicism on the south. The building was originally used for a variety of purposes ranging from dormitories, offices to a gymnasium. The gymnasium had a mezzanine inserted and was converted for use as a Radio Control Room. The building will house an interpretation room and a police service centre, with shops and restaurants.

警察總部大樓於1919年落成,是中區警署建築群最宏偉的建築物之一,也是建築群中最為公眾熟知的建築物,外觀設計結合不同風格,包括向北外牆的新古典復古設計,以及南面外牆的簡樸及小規模古典設計。大樓曾闢作不同用途,包括宿舍、辦公室及健身室,而健身室內的閣樓,曾被改為無線電控制室。大樓將設置詮釋空間、警察服務中心、商店及餐廳。






The Armoury's works started in 1924 and was used as a stable for Japanese mounted guards (thus the building's alternate name is the Stable Block). In the late 20th century, the building was used as offices for the Traffic Police. **The building will be used as a restaurant.**


BARRACK BLOCK 營房大樓

One of the oldest buildings on the site, the Barrack Block was built between 1862 and 1864 and is situated on the southern side of the Parade Ground. It was originally built as a three-storey structure, with an additional storey added in 1906 to accommodate the expansion of the police force. The building played a major role on the site and formed the backdrop to ceremonies held on the Parade Ground. In the late 1920s, the block housed offices for the Criminal Investigation Department. The Barrack Block will have interpretation spaces with areas for shops and restaurants.



The Married Inspectors' Quarters was built between 1862 and 1864 and is one of the oldest buildings on site. **Two-third of the original buildings remains and will be designated for not-for-profit office use, with the Visitor Centre on the ground floor.**



The Married Sergeants' Quarters was built between 1900 and 1903, and was previously used as a dormitory block. This building will be used to accommodate artists-in-residence, with the extension of the Visitor Centre and a restaurant on the ground floor.

The Single Inspectors' Quarters was built between 1900 and 1903. The building is significant for its mix of classical western design and Chinese elements, such as verandahs and traditional tile roofing. This building was used as a dormitory and designed to be of domestic scale.


The building will be used to accommodate artists-in-residence.

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


The Ablutions Block's construction year was unknown, but appeared on plans starting from the 1930s and was linked to the Barrack Block. Formerly a sanitary building, it was also the site of the original stables, coolies' quarters and kitchens for the Barrack Block. The building will be strengthened structurally and used for back-of-house facilities and a plant room.



The Central Magistracy was first established in the 1840s and underwent two reconstructions. The current structure was built between 1912 and 1914 and is one of the most significant buildings on site. The colonial architecture was a symbol of the importance and power of the court. The building is notable for its connection to the police and prison functions that provided an "all-in-one" service. Following the end of the Japanese occupation in 1945, the Central Magistracy was used as a tribunal for war crime trials. A courtroom and basement cells will be used as interpretation spaces, while the main building will be used for an integrated cultural and leisure offering.

The Superintendent's House was built in late 19th century. It was used as the main entrance to the prison. The building was used as both quarters and offices for the prison superintendent. By the mid-20th century, the building was converted into an Accounts office. Adjoined to the Superintendent's House, C Hall was constructed in the early 20th century and was used as the prison canteen, reception area for an immigration office and workshops.

These buildings will be transformed into a space for restaurants, shops, not-forprofit office use, and additional back-ofhouse facilities.







Built in 1945, A Hall is one of the youngest buildings on the site. The design is both practical and functional. The building was used as office space and a room on the ground floor was used as a chapel in later years. Its last known use was an immigration office.

The building will be used for education and community facilities.



B Hall's works began in 1910 and was used as a prison cell block. It is a good example of a small-scale prison. It will be used for interpretation space and kept in its existing state to provide visitors with an authentic impression of the prison conditions.




D Hall's works began in 1858. It is one of the oldest buildings left and the only surviving remnant of the 'radial plan' prison. Over time, the hall served various functions such as a female prison and later, male and female hospitals. The building will now house not-for-profit office use, a restaurant, interpretation space, as well as back-of-house facilities.

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
E Hall's works began in 1915 and it is visible from both Arbuthnot Road and Chancery Lane. In the past, the building provided the public face of the prison to the outside world. Constructed using prison labour, the building is of similar design to B Hall.

The building will house a ticketing office, a reception hall, a lounge and back-of-house facilities for the multi-purpose venue at the new 'Arbuthnot Auditorium'.



F Hall was built in the early 20th century originally as a print shop. Situated on one of the most reworked areas of the site, the building is significant for its social history. It was used after 1956 as the Reception Centre for visitors – providing a link between the prison and the outside world. F Hall will provide interpretation space, gallery space and a 'pop up' space for cultural events.






The building was originally designed as a guard house in 1858. In 1984, it became the first halfway house for the rehabilitation of women offenders and was named Bauhinia House. The building will be used as an entrance to the CPS site.





'Arbuthnot Auditorium' will house a multi-purpose hall suitable for film screenings, conferences, seminars and educational activities. The building will be connected to the back-of-house facilities in D and E Halls. It will have a covered open space and audience seating on the ground floor. The supporting plant room and the district cooling system are also located at the building.



There are two major open spaces on the site: the Parade Ground and the Prison Yard. The Parade Ground in the police complex witnessed many police events and ceremonies, but was used as a car park in more modern times. The Prison Yard was used as a space for prisoners to exercise. In future, both open spaces, together with other open spaces on the site, will be used for holding public programmes and entertainment.

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HISTORY OF THE SITE 建築群的歷史

Dating back to the mid-19th century, the site is home to some of the earliest structures to be built under colonial rule and has developed in tune with the city around it. It now forms a unique cluster of low-rise heritage buildings sitting in a single prime location in the heart of the city. Its significance was recognised in 1995 when the Central Police Station, the Central Magistracy and the Victoria Prison were designated as Declared Monuments.

中區警署建築群的歷史可追溯至19世紀中葉,當中部分建築物始建於殖民統治初期,並與香港社會同步發展,至今已成為中區核心地段上獨特的低密度文物建築群。中區警署、中央裁判司署和域多利監獄於1995年被列為法定古蹟,進一步肯定了建築群的文物價值。

1932-1939

Victoria Gaol was briefly closed after prisoners were transferred to newly-built Lai Chi Kok Prison and Stanley Prison. It reopened in 1939.

1946

The Central Magistracy was used in 1946 as a war crimes tribunal.
The Central Police Station and Victoria Gaol reopened after the post-war repairs and constructions.

MATURING YEARS 成熟時期

1941-1945

The compound suffered severe bomb damage in December 1941 and was subsequently used by the Japanese military until the end of WWII.

1967

During the 1967 Riots which were widespread, many police stations were attacked. 51 people lost their lives, including several policemen.

Captain William Caine was appointed Chief Magistrate to establish law and order and oversee construction of the first magistracy and prison

Prison overcrowding due to an increase in population and crime led to the redevelopment of Victoria Gaol based on radial plan.

1893

In 1893, Governor Sir William Robinson approved a further prison extension.

New buildings were added and part of the Victoria Gaol radial plan prison was demolished leaving a T-shaped prison.

1893年,港督威廉,羅便臣批准擴建監獄, 拆除域多利監獄部分「米字型」監倉,因此 留下「T字形」建築,亦興建新建築物以增 加囚禁規模。

1919

GROWING YEARS 發展時期

The new Central Police Station
Headquarters Block was completed
on a plot north of the Barrack Block.
The façade facing Hollywood Road was
built in a Neo-Classical style.

中區警署總部大樓落成,座落於營房大樓 北面,面向荷李活道的大樓正面屬新古典 復古設計。

FORMATIVE YEARS 孕育時期

1844-1845

The Colonial Police Force was offically established. Charles May was appointed Superintendent of Police and suggested the reconstruction of gaols and a new magistracy.

殖民地警隊正式成立,查理士·梅理 成為警察總監,並建議改建監獄及 裁判司署。

1862-1866

Colonial Police Force expanded and the Central Police Station was moved from Wellington Street to the site. After 1866, the site began to serve the functions of police station, magistracy and prison, forming a close-knitted law enforcement system.

殖民地警隊規模擴大,中區警署由威靈頓街 遷往現址。1866年後,中區警署建築群開始發揮 警署、裁判司署及監獄功能,成為執法核心。

1915

189

The new Central Magistracy was reconstructed in 1912-1914 to house two courtrooms. The Central Magistracy opened for its first judical session in April 1915.

中央裁判司署於1912至1914年間進行改建。 新中央裁判司署設有兩個法庭,並於1915年 4月展開首個審訊。

1931-1933

Future leader of Vietnam, Ho Chi Minh, was arrested and held in Victoria Gaol.

未來越南領袖胡志明於1931至1933期間 囚禁於域多利監獄。

1979

841

Hong Kong became the port of first asylum for Vietnam refugees. Part of Victoria Gaol, Central Magistracy and many other buildings were converted for Immigration Department's use.

香港成為越南難民第一收容港, 域多利監獄和中央裁判司署部分地方, 以及多幢建築物,被改為供入境處使用。

1995

The Central Police Station, Central Magistracy, and Victoria Gaol were declared as monuments under the Antiquities and Monuments Ordinance.

根據《古物及古蹟條例》,中區警署、中央裁判司署及域多利監獄,被列為法令土等。

2006

The Central Police Station Compound was decommissioned. In 2007, The Hong Kong Jockey Club announced a not-for-profit plan to fund the revitalisation of the Central Police Station.

2006年,中區警署建築群結役;2007年,香港賽馬會公佈資助活化中區警署建築群的非牟利計劃。

DECLINING YEARS 引退時期

1984

Bauhinia House was converted into a half-way house for women under supervision by the Correctional Services Department (formerly the Prisons Department).

懲教署(前身為監獄署)將紫荊樓改為中途 宿舍,供獲釋而須受監管的女性所員入住。

TRANSFORMING YEARS 活化時期

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
